- Pass by Palatine Hill to see Circus Maximus, the stadium where ancient Romans raced chariots, and the Baths of Caracalla.

Day 3: Ancient Rome: St. Paul's Basilica & the Catacombs

From \$95.00 . Visit the link above for pricing info. (4 hours, departure time varies)

Descend into Rome's ancient catacombs, where early Christians buried saints and popes alongside commoners. A local guide will lead you through the burial chambers before your visit to St. Paul's Basilica, one of the four most important basilicas of Rome. Originally founded by Constantine the Great, the Basilica also houses the tomb of St. Paul. Please note: Shorts and sleeveless shirts are not permitted within the Basilica. Also, this excursion involves extensive walking and may be challenging for claustrophobic travelers.

Day 4: Iconic Sights: Vatican City

This guided tour takes you inside Vatican City—a UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of the most sacred places in Christendom. This independent city-state within Rome serves as the headquarters of the Roman Catholic Church and is home to the Pope. Upon arrival, turn on your pre-distributed headset and dive into the Vatican's rich history with your local guide. First, visit the Vatican Museums, which are more than 500 years old and house many of the world's most important Classical- and Renaissance-era sculptures. Next, step inside the Sistine Chapel, whose frescoed ceiling is arguably Michelangelo's greatest masterpiece. Finally, pay a visit to the enormous St. Peter's Basilica, the epicenter of the Roman Catholic faith. The artists who have contributed to its glory are some of the best Italy has ever known—Bramante, Peruzzi, Raphael, and Michelangelo. Masterpieces await at every turn, from Bernini's magnificent bronze canopy to Michelangelo's Madonna della Pietà.

Please note: Should this excursion fall on a Sunday, it'll be moved to another day of the tour. Backpacks aren't allowed in the Vatican, and shorts and sleeveless shirts are strictly prohibited. Due to closures of certain entrances and pathways, wait times may extend to several hours during busy travel months. From December 24, 2024, to January 6, 2026, the Jubilee may impact if and when this excursion can run or which parts of the Basilica can be accessed. Access to Michelangelo's La Pietà is also impacted during this time. On certain days, the Basilica will only be accessible to pilgrims and might involve long waiting times. Should you wish to enter on these days, your tour director will explain the procedure and the local guide will not be able to accompany you inside. If your excursion is cancelled completely, Go Ahead will let you know in advance.

Day 4: Food of Rome: Walking Tour of Trastevere

Meet up with a local guide for a culinary-themed walking tour of Trastevere. This historic neighborhood is located across the Tiber River and is home to some of the Rome's best shops, bars, and restaurants. Step inside four handpicked eateries, each of which showcases the area's rich culinary traditions. You'll enjoy tastings of aperitivo, pasta, pastries, and gelato—all quintessential Italian foods. Over an aperitivo and a glass of wine, your guide will talk about the various flavors and cooking techniques that have come to define the local cuisine. Watch locals go about their daily lives as you stroll along the charming trattoria-lined streets during your tour.

Day 5: Castel Gandolfo & Wine Tasting

Leave the city behind and enjoy an afternoon in Lazio's wine country. Begin your excursion with a stop at Castel Gandolfo, a gorgeous village located on the shores of Lake Albano. You'll have the opportunity to stroll through the square that's home to the Papal Palace, the Pope's summer residence, which you can step inside and explore. Later, you'll travel to a vineyard for a wine tasting, where you'll sample a variety of wines as well as homemade olive oils and other specialties.

Day 6: Ancient Roman Ruins of Ostia Antica

Situated on the Mediterranean at the mouth of the Tiber River, Ostia was once the bustling seaport for the city of Rome and home to more than 50,000 people in the second century. When the Roman Empire fell, the port was abandoned and eventually covered in silt from the river—a natural phenomenon that preserved much of the ancient architecture. You'll take a guided tour of the excavated city, viewing the remnants of the ancient Roman ruins, including a forum, a theater, bars and restaurants, public baths, religious temples, and apartment blocks, many of which are still decorated with the original mosaics and painted walls.

Extension excursion options

Day 8: Siena & San Gimignano: Tuscan Hill Towns

Discover the essence of Tuscany on a full-day excursion. In Siena, a local guide introduces you to the town and its black-and-white marble duomo, where you'll find brilliantly colored 16th-century frescoes in the Piccolomini Library. You'll have some free time to explore the Campo, the square that serves as the center of civic life in Siena. Then, journey through the countryside to the town of San Gimignano, where you'll have some free time to explore the city's medieval towers or simply admire the Tuscan hills. Later, you'll head to a nearby vineyard, where an included wine tasting awaits. Please note: This excursion involves a

moderate amount of walking across hilly terrain with some steep inclines.

Day 9: Accademia Gallery

Home to Michelangelo's masterpiece David, the Accademia Gallery is one of the most famous museums in Florence. Skip the ticket lines, and join a local guide on a tour of the museum as you learn about Renaissance art history and view a variety of pieces, including the marble statue of David.
