Day 1: Travel day

Board your overnight flight to Rome today.

Day 2: Arrival in Italy

Included meals: welcome dinner Welcome to Italy! Meet your fellow travelers at tonight's welcome dinner.

Day 3: Sightseeing tour of Rome

Included meals: breakfast Follow in the footsteps of the ancient Romans on a guided tour of the Eternal City.

- Soak up over 2,000 years of history in Imperial Rome, viewing the Arch of Constantine and the Arch of Titus
- Enter the Colosseum, the largest amphitheater of the Roman Empire
- Stop at the ruins of the Forum, once the setting of parades, elections, and trials
- Pass Palatine Hill, see where ancient Romans raced chariots at Circus Maximus, and view the Baths of Caracalla

Day 4: Anzio battlefields

Included meals: breakfast

Take a half-day excursion to Anzio Beach, an important Allied Forces landing spot during the Battle of Anzio.

- Visit Anzio Beachhead Museum to learn about the battle and view the museum's many artifacts and memorabilia
- Stop to visit Anzio War Cemetery
- Enjoy free time for lunch before heading back
 to Rome

Spend another free evening in Rome or add an excursion.

Day 5: Naples via Monte Cassino

Included meals: breakfast, dinner En route to Naples, stop at Monte Cassino to tour sites used during the battle that took place here during WWII.

- Enter the Abbey of Monte Cassino, which was completely destroyed during an American-led air raid and rebuilt after the war
- See the Cassino War Cemetery and the land that was used during the Battle of Monte Cassino

After, continue on to Naples and sit down for an included dinner.

Day 6: Sightseeing tour of Naples

Included meals: breakfast

This morning's guided sightseeing tour introduces you to the highlights of Naples, a beautiful bayside city.

- Enjoy a panoramic tour with a scenic drive along the Naples waterfront
- Pass Castel dell'Ovo, the seaside castle on a peninsula in the Bay of Naples
- Visit the National Archaeological Museum and see relics of Roman history

Enjoy a free afternoon and evening or add an excursion.

Day 7: Ortona via Moro River Canadian War Cemetery

Included meals: breakfast, dinner Today, visit the Moro River Canadian War Cemetery. When you arrive in Ortona, enter the Museo della Battaglia di Ortona to learn about the conflict that took place here between Canadian troops and Nazi Germany. This evening, sit down for an included dinner.

Day 8: San Marino via Battle of Rimini Sites

Included meals: breakfast, dinner Travel along Italy's Adriatic Coast en route to San Marino and stop to see sites from the Battle of Rimini.

- Visit the Gradara War Cemetery
- See the Gothic Line Q204, a memorial which remembers the Canadian lives lost during WWII

After, continue on to San Marino and sit down for an included dinner.

Day 9: Sightseeing tour of San Marino

Included meals: breakfast

This morning, set off on a guided tour of the Republic of San Marino, a mountainous state located near the Adriatic Sea.

- Stroll along the cobblestone streets through the city of San Marino, known to the locals as Città
- Walk through the walled, medieval old town to see Palazzo Pubblico and the Basilica of San Marino

Enjoy free time to eat lunch and visit the Three Towers of San Marino, located on top of Mount Titano.

Day 10: Florence via Florence War Cemetery

Included meals: breakfast

Transfer from San Marino to Florence stopping at the Florence War Cemetery en route. Then, spend a free afternoon in the city or add an excursion.

Day 11: Sightseeing tour of Florence

Included meals: breakfast, farewell dinner Set off to see Florence, the city at the center of the Renaissance, with a local guide.

- Visit the legendary Florence Cathedral, known as the Duomo
- Pass Giotto's Campanile, a masterpiece of Gothic architecture
- See the medieval Ponte Vecchio and the Piazza della Signoria, the center of Florentine life
- Step inside the Basilica of Santa Croce, the burial site of Michelangelo, Machiavelli, and Galileo

This evening, join your group for a farewell dinner.

Day 12: Departure

Day 3: Iconic Sights: Vatican City

From \$185.00 CAD. Visit the link above for pricing info. (3.5 hours, departure time varies) This guided tour takes you inside Vatican City-a UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of the most sacred places in Christendom. This independent citystate within Rome serves as the headquarters of the Roman Catholic Church and is home to the Pope. Upon arrival, turn on your pre-distributed headset and dive into the Vatican's rich history with your local guide. First, visit the Vatican Museums, which are more than 500 years old and house many of the world's most important Classical- and Renaissance-era sculptures. Next, step inside the Sistine Chapel, whose frescoed ceiling is arguably Michelangelo's greatest masterpiece. Finally, pay a visit to the enormous St. Peter's Basilica, the epicenter of the Roman Catholic faith. The artists who have contributed to its glory are some of the best Italy has ever known-Bramante, Peruzzi, Raphael, and Michelangelo. Masterpieces await at every turn, from Bernini's magnificent bronze canopy to Michelangelo's Madonna della Pieta.

Please note: Should this excursion fall on a Sunday, it'll be moved to another day of the tour. Backpacks aren't allowed in the Vatican, and shorts and sleeveless shirts are strictly prohibited. Due to closures of certain entrances and pathways, wait times may extend to several hours during busy travel months. From December 24, 2024, to January 6, 2026, the Jubilee may impact if and when this excursion can run or which parts of the Basilica can be accessed. Access to Michelangelo's La Pieta is also impacted during this time. On certain days, the Basilica will only be accessible to pilgrims and might involve long waiting times. Should you wish to enter on these days, your tour director will explain the procedure and the local guide will not be able to accompany you inside. If your excursion is cancelled completely. Go Ahead will let you know in advance.

Day 4: Dinner with Tenors

End your day with an elegant, four-course dinner at a local restaurant. While you dine, you'll be treated to some of opera's best-loved arias, sung by professional tenors, and you might even join the singers on stage. Don't miss this lighthearted evening of food and fun! Please note: This excursion is seasonal and runs from March through November. Please note: Due to restaurant closures, all 2021 departures of the Dinner with Tenors experience will feature live music at a historic osteria in the Trastevere neighborhood.

Day 6: Royal Palace of Caserta & Gardens

Join a local guide for a walking tour of 18th-century, Royal Palace of Caserta and its acclaimed English Gardens. The UNESCO-listed, Baroque-style palace is one of the largest in Europe and was used as the headquarters for the Allied troops during WWII. In addition, the palace was where Germany signed the terms to their surrender on the Italian front, and where the first Allied war crimes trial took place. After touring the palace, discover the accompanying gardens, which were inspired by the landscapes of Versailles. Stroll through the flora-filled paths to see the park's many fountains, baths, and statues.

Day 10: Villa Machiavelli Dinner

(4 hours, departs in the evening, dinner included) Nestled in the Tuscan countryside, just outside of Florence sits the majestic Machiavelli Villa, a historic 14th-century villa perched on a hill surrounded by lush vineyards and olive groves. Home to Niccolo Machiavelli during his exile from Florence in the early 1500's, this sprawling estate-turned-museum not only boasts an impressive history but also produces awardwinning wines and olive oils. Start your evening with a glass of Prosecco before touring the villa rooms. Then, enjoy a refined multi-course Italian dinner with local wine, taking in the landscape and beauty of Tuscany surrounding you. Please note: This excursions is seasonal and runs from March–October.

Extension excursion options

Day 4: Taormina

Visit the link above for pricing info. (5 hours, departs in the morning)

Head to Taormina where a local guide will introduce you to this scenic city perched high above the sea. Enjoy views of Mount Etna, Taormina Cathedral, and Palazzo Corvaia, seat of the first Sicilian parliament. Then, visit the town's 2nd-century Greek theater and enjoy free time in the area, before returning to Catania.

Day 4: Mount Etna Wine Region Tasting & Dinner

(4 hours, departs in the evening with dinner) Travel to the Etna wine region for a traditional Sicilian dinner and wine tasting on the grounds of a local vineyard estate. The area's volcanic soil and distinctive climate infuse the wines with an intense and pleasing minerality that perfectly complements traditional Sicilian cooking. You'll sip on Etna Rosso blends made of the sleek nerello mascalese and nerello cappuccio grapes while in view of the majestic Mount Etna.
